Cell Phone Recommendation — Off While Flying!

Mila Petrik reminds us of the article by Mark Bertuzzi (MAAC Radio Spectrum Committee Chair) published in the March/April edition of the MAC magazine. In the article, Mark recommends we turn off our phones while flying. Article reprinted below.

Since 2006, MAAC members have enjoyed the benefits of Digital Spread Spectrum radios using frequencies in the 2.4 GHZ band. We use channels, up to 1 MHZ wide, with frequencies ranging from 2.400 to 2.4835 GHz. These frequencies are in the Industrial, Scientific and Medical (ISM) band, which is also a licence and fee-exempt.

Sharing the band with us are Bluetooth devices, First Person View video links, Amateur Radio operators, and Wi-Fi devices.

Bluetooth devices include hearing aid controllers and headsets to communicate with cell phones.

WI-FI is also installed in GOPRO cameras and recently, tests were conducted to see if it is possible to simulate the loss of radio control if the GOPRO WI-FI is turned on. Antenna fades and holds all increased with an on-board GOPRO camera was turned on.

As more and more electronic devices operate in this band, the potential for radio interference increases. Reports have been received of suspected radio interference from Bluetooth devices, and under the right conditions -- which may occur in the vicinity of multiple users -- there could be incidents

of loss of control of your radio control equipped device.

Until further advised, it is recommended to shut off your Bluetooth and WI-FI devices as well as turning off or placing your cellphone in Airplane mode when flying. After all, we don't want any distracted flyers at the flight line.

Please contact any of the Radio Spectrum Committee members if you require more information. If you have a suspected interference issue, please note time and location of the suspected interference and let us know.
