CUSTOMIZE YOUR ARF

Just a short note to those that have not built a kit, if you are doing an ARF then think about modifying it to personalize for your self. The pic shows an LT40 Kadet wing from an ARF kit.

I put some 1" wide masking tape down on the wing where I wanted the scallops and marked the ribs on the lower edge as they are not even, also making sure to mark the ends of the wing on the tape, then using a very thin ruler I bent it to fit in between two marks and put the top of the arc on the top edge of the tape and drew a line. Once you have the tape marked all the way, you just pull it off of the wing and place it on your new cover and cut out the scallops. I cut the old cover ahead of the main spar and just under the leading edge, remove old cover. Place new cover and tape on wing lining up the end marks and positioning the scallop where you had put the tape originally, tac

scallop down thru the masking tape and then proceed to stretch new cover over the wing normally. Remove bits of masking tape and voila a new look.


