### NOISE MEASUREMENT

Over the recent past, as a club we have slipped a bit in our adherence to noise testing rules; the fact that our noise meter was stolen didn't help.

In general, we don't have a noise problem, but recently there have been some noisier planes flown at the field.

The executive is in the process of purchasing a new meter and will advise members of how we are to log or mark our planes as "noise tested & suitable for operation" at the CARFF Bawtinheimer Field.

The rules and requirements have been in place for some time; nothing new in the notes below:

- 1. **Any** model's noise is not to exceed 99dB(A) as measured 9 feet from the engine (both sides and front).
- 2. No model exceeding the above to be flown at the CARFF Field.
- 3. Non members are subject to the same requirement: if a member invites a guest to fly at the CARFF Field, it is the member's responsibility to ensure all models flown by the guest comply with the noise limit.
- 4. It is every member's responsibility to request a sound-check of any plane if there is doubt that the model exceeds the noise limit.

2020 will be the year of the sound test: all our planes, jet, IC & even electric are to be tested and logged.

- Any changes to prop size, muffler, engine will require a retest.
- · Moving a compliant engine to a different airframe will require a retest.

Come out to the field at 2:00 PM Sunday October 6th and learn how to use the new meter!. The weather forecast looks very promising for a great flying day.

Also, it has been an unwritten rule that we avoid, as far as practical, flying to the north-east of the field (i.e. near the house to the north east).

### **Special Note Regarding Guest Pilots**

Members are welcome to invite guests to occasionally fly at the CARFF field BUT if "occasionally" turns out to be "frequently" then the person is expected to join the club and pay membership dues.
