The Jumgmeister project continues. Pretty much all covered now. Lots of details to finish. Power is a DLE 20RA. Fits nicely into the nose. With the tank accessible from the firewall, the gas engine install was good. Motor mounts could be lower and longer but I think they will work fine. Decals were a little more pricey than I hoped for so some of them will remain missing for a while.



Paint for the cowling is still being decided on, again first quotes were really spendy. Not being set up for spraying any more does come at a cost.

The silver Ultra Cote is nice but every little flaw even dust shows through because of the reflective characteristics.

Might not make it to the field this spring, but there is always the Arrowmaster, Ballerina, and the new Peggy Sue to fly. Lots of airplanes in the hangar right now, so picking one


or two for an event is

getting harder each time.

The cowl is aluminum and the blistetrs are plastic. Will need a coat of filling primer before it gets paint. Because I'm going to gas I can use a spray bomb silver poly or enamel. I think I will look for poly.

You can see a plywood former in the cowl. This is required to get the intake air volume sized correctly for the available exhaust air. Enough weight involved that this not a plane to fly without the cowl.

I am not happy with the windscreen so I think its getting cut off and redone.


The last indoor event of the season was well attended - 14 flyers. Unfortunately, I was unable to attend; this did not go unnoticed by several club members :(
